Directions:

FROM RUSTENBURG:

Take the Swartruggens / Zeerust road. At T-junction (at the bottom of the hill) turn right. Follow the road through Phokeng (plenty of stop streets) and on through Boshhoek. After Boshhoek, find fork in road. Lead right. Sundown Ranch is situated about 10km further on.

FROM PRETORIA:

Take the Sun City highway (about 20km after Hartebeespoort Dam). After you Pass Sun City on your right, follow through small village, (Ledig) to Fourway-crossing. Follow signs left to R565 Rustenburg. Sundown Ranch Hotel is situated about 5km on, on the right-hand side.
