FAO Committee on Forestry 2007:

- 128 Countries + 37 IGO's
- Fire management well covered
- Recommended FAO, countries & partners to:
 - strengthen technical support in fire management
 - finalize Strategy
 - facilitate implementation of Guidelines
 - maintain Guidelines as a living document





Fire Management Actions Alliance

- 4th pillar of the Strategy
